# **College Strength**

The College has the optimum student admission in all courses with a total strength of 1,614.

This year three new courses were introduced .In Under graduate level BSc. Horticulture and in Post graduate level M.Sc Agronomy and MSc. Physics.

# **University Results**

The performance of Dolphinites in the University Examinations has been consistently well. The annual result of the college is generally much higher than the university average.

In Undergraduate Courses toppers of all streams have scored above 80% with highest in Agriculture by Lenin Laishram (88%) and in Postgraduate Courses Grade point average is above 8.0 with highest in Biotechnology by Surya Prashad Sharma Grade point average (8.6). I am happy to share Rehab Gani from department of Zoology ranked first in the University merit list. Number of students qualified NET/GATE/ SLET were 09.

I congratulate the rank holders and the respective Departments for their achievements.

### **Placement**

You will appreciate that the backbone of any professional institute like ours is its placement. The Institute has a good placement record since its inception and placement cell continued with its initiative of building strong relationships between Industries and students. Ten Industry Orientation Programmes and Industrial visits were organized

More than 80% students were recruited through campus selection. I am happy to share that placement cell had more opportunities than students to avail them.

### **Research Activities**

Institute has duly entered in the field of research activities and has enrolled students for Ph.D programme.

The faculty members also have published books, chapters and research papers in the peer reviewed indexed Journals. Faculty and students participated in various national & International conferences & workshops.

State level – 25, National level – 19, International level – 08

04 faculties were resource persons in State and two were in National level conferences.

09 Workshops, Seminars and CME were conducted in the year by different Departments. They were Dept. of Biotechnology, Physiotherapy, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Botany, Forestry and Biostatistics.

Till date Ten projects funded by Government agencies and 01 consultancy project funded by Non-Govt. International agency has been carried out by the faculty of the Institute.

Presently 05 projects are ongoing, 01 funded by DBT in dept. of Microbiology, 03 projects funded by Uttarakhand State Biotechnology in dept. of Biotechnology, Microbiology, Chemistry & Microbiology jointly, and 01 project funded by Punjab State Science & Technology Council in dept of Agriculture & Biostatistics jointly.

Beside this International Biodiversity Day, Science Day, Environment Day, Immunology Day, World Heart Day, AIDS Day, Physiotherapy Day, World Diabetes Day, World Wild life Day were also celebrated in the Institute.

# **Sports**
