University Results

The performance of Dolphinites in the University Examinations has been consistently well. The annual result of the college is generally much higher than the university average.

In Undergraduate Courses toppers of all streams have scored above 80%. Pate Talo from Dept. of Agriculture 83.77%, Ritwika Mukhopadhyay from Dept. of Forestry 83.66%, Ankita Belwal from Dept. of Agriculture 83.55%

In Postgraduate Courses Grade point average is above 8.0 Neha Bisht from Dept. of Biochemistry scored 8.63, Thupten Tsering from Dept. of Botany 8.42, Nishma Manhas, Neelam Firdaus from Dept. of Zoology & Vikas Roathan from Dept. of Biotechnology scored 8.33 each.

Social Commitments of the Institute:

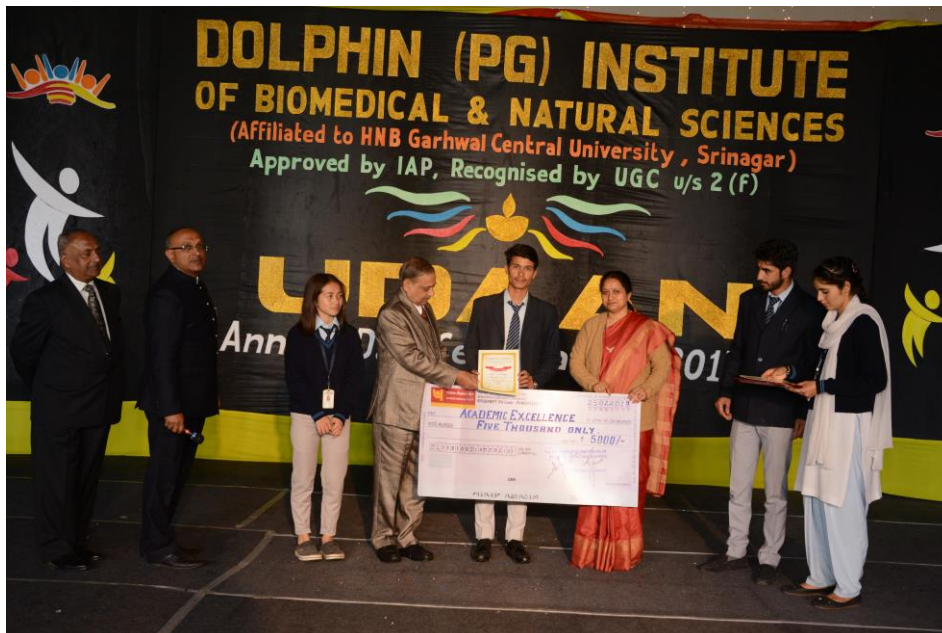
The institute has a student's welfare council to look after the general social and welfare needs of the students.
