Two Days Workshop on

Intellectual Property Rights Concluded

A two days workshop on IPR (Intelectual Property Right) was organised jointly by Research Advisory Committee and Department of Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Dolphin (P.G.) Institute of Biomedical & Natural Sciences, Dehradun on 10th & 11th March 2022. Workshop began with the lighting of lamp by the Chief Guest Dr. S. Farukhi, Chairman, Himalayan Wellness Company Dehradun and Guest of Honour Dr. D. P. Uniyal, Joint Director, UCOST. Dr. Shailja Pant, Principal, Dolphin (P.G.) Institute welcomed the guests. Dr. Versha Percha, Coordinator of the workshop introduced the guests and briefed about the importance of the workshop. Second day workshop commenced with the lecture by Dr. Aparna Sharma, Senior Scientific Officer, UCOST titled Role of UCOST in sensitization of IPR in Uttarakhand. Addressing the participants present in her lecture, she said that every person's research work is for the service of the public and society, but it is the result of his hard work, so no one else can take personal benefit by copying him through IPR. UCOST constantly keeps providing information to the people by conducting an awareness program on it.

Shri Himanshu Goel, Scientist-B, P.I.C. UCOST, presented his views on Copyright and Plagiarism. He told that when a person creates any work in original i.e. he stores it in physical medium, and then the copyright of that work goes to that person. If a person steals the original work then it is called plagiarism. It is also known as literary theft.

Both the lectures were followed by a guiz and interactive session wherein researchers, students, scientists from different institutions interacted with each other about their research problems and experts resolved their problems and doubts. 
